

2012 ATLANTA PROFESSIONAL BOCCELISM

The 2012 Atlanta Professional Boccelism Regular Season is just around the corner. Boccelism, Inc. is back as a sponsor for the Championship Tournament.

HOW TO PLAY

A \$20 registration fee qualifies each player for the season; also available are \$5 Weekend Passes for players, guests, or visitors who cannot commit to the full season. Players may apply the purchase price of Weekend Passes to the registration fee if they later decide to complete the season. All funds generated through fees and passes will be applied to cover expenses for the season.

FORMAT

All event days are initially designated as Open Tossing, with individuals challenging each other for supremacy; however, players are welcome to mutually agree to play blind-draw tournaments or mini-tournaments with prizes determined by the players. Players may play up to a total of 18 cases during the season, with a minimum of 8 cases played needed to qualify for the tournament. Players may play each other a total of three times during the regular season, after which any additional matches will be considered “friendlies” which do not count toward qualifying or against the case limit.

Up to 12 players can qualify for the Championship Tournament, with the top four regular season finishers earning byes for the Play-in Round. Regular season rankings are based on Tournament Points (see www.boccelism.com/glossary.php).

CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

The Play-in Round is scheduled to take place on Saturday, September 15th, with the Championship Tournament currently slated for 2 pm Saturday, September 29th, 2012. If less than a full slate of matches is necessary for the Play-in Round, those cases may be played on Championship Saturday.

The Championship Tournament will have a minimum prize pool of \$500; any expense money not spent during the season will be rolled into the Championship prize pool. The final eight players will receive payouts at these percentages: 1st – 40%; 2nd – 20%; 3rd/4th – 10%; 5th-8th - 5%.
